VOLUNTEERS NEEDED AT THE BEACH

JOIN US FOR SANDY SCIENCE AT THE BEACH!

Sandy beaches are continually changing, sometimes threatening structures and wildlife. Your help is needed to document these changes so we can better understand and manage these valuable systems.

Dedicated volunteers are needed to conduct simple surveys on sandy beaches in the Santa Barbara and Ventura

CONDUCT SIMPLE SURVEYS ONCE PER MONTH AT LOW TIDE

- Measure changes in the beach slope using two measuring sticks as you walk – no need to get your feet wet!
- Record data and take pictures.

The data will show seasonal changes and human impacts on beaches. This will help scientists better understand the dynamics of sandy beaches.



WANT TO VOLUNTEER?

- No prior experience needed. In-field training and materials are provided.
- Volunteers work in teams of three. Individuals, clubs, groups and classes welcome.
- Volunteers must be 12 or older (children under 18 must be with an adult).
